The market and in particular, BitcoinSV (BSV), rallied aggressively into the weekend following further developments relating to the ongoing Craig Wright and “Tulip Trust” saga. In particular, the self-proclaimed Bitcoin creator submitted a total of 428 documents to the plaintiffs, one of them allegedly including details of a trust that holds billions of dollars-worth of bitcoin.

Mr. Wright’s legal counselors marked the paper “Tulip Trust III” as confidential. The move raised suspicions that their client was indeed involved in the mining of first batch of Bitcoin. By Sunday, BSV was trading in mid-\$160 zone, having traded around \$120 on Friday morning. Elsewhere, Ethereum Classic (ETC) successfully completed the “Agharta” hard fork at block number 9,573,000 at 06:26 UTC on Sunday, according to etcnodes.org. Similar to the network’s last backwards-incompatible upgrade in September, Atlantis, Agharta makes Ethereum Classic more interoperable with sister-chain Ethereum.

As part of the hard fork, the Constantinople and St. Petersburg upgrades deployed in tandem on the Ethereum network last February will be enabled under Ethereum Classic Improvement Proposal (ECIP) 1056. ETC has made a strong start to the year on expectations that the interoperability will entice some miners to switch from Ethereum chain to Classic chain.
